The City of Edmonton currently has Primrose Park (located at 8304 188 Street) rated in “**fair**” condition. This means as the playground ages and the features of the playground reach the end of their life cycle they will be **removed**. In effort to maintain and ensure that the park remains an exciting and fun place for our children to use, we need to make significant improvements to the park in the form of a complete rebuild.

A committee has been created and is operating and being governed by the Aldergrove Community League.
